SUBJECT: National Guard and Federal Law Enforcement Assistance

CALEA STANDARDS: 2.1.4

NOTE: This written directive is for the internal governance of the Littleton Police Department, and as provided by RSA 516:36, is not intended and should not be interpreted to establish a higher standard of care in any civil or criminal action than would otherwise be applicable under existing law.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to govern the request for mutual aid from the New Hampshire National Guard or federal law enforcement.

POLICY

No request for the assistance of the New Hampshire National Guard or federal law enforcement shall be made without the express permission of the Chief of Police, Deputy Chief of Police or his designee.

PROCEDURE

National Guard

- If the circumstances of a criminal event warrant the request of the New Hampshire National Guard, the Chief of Police or Deputy Chief of Police shall contact the Office of the Governor of the State at 271-2121 and request the activation of the National Guard pursuant to RSA 110-B:6, Ordering National Guard into Active State Service.

Federal Law Enforcement

- If the circumstances of a criminal event warrant the request for assistance from a federal law enforcement agency, the Chief of Police, Deputy Chief of Police or his designee shall contact the nearest station or office of the applicable agency.
